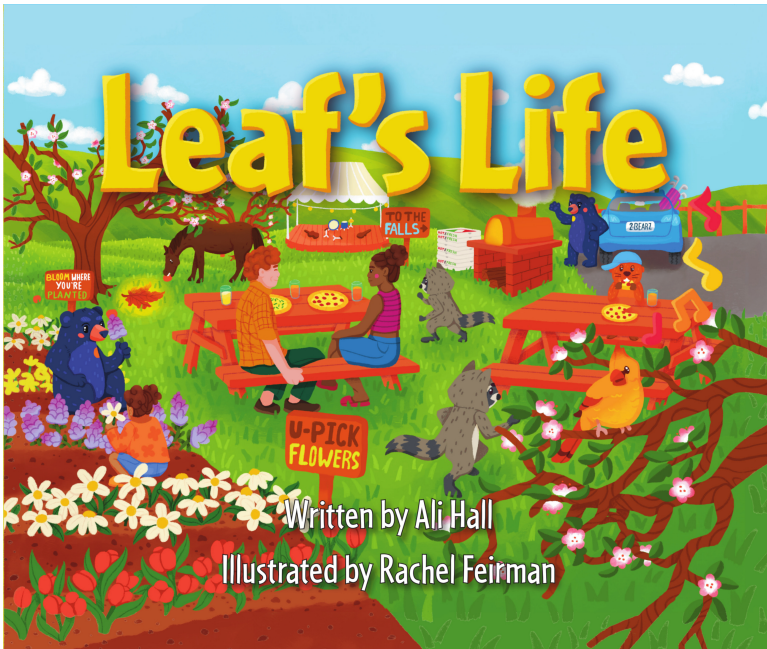


LEAF'S LIFE
